



Visiting Assistant Professor - Architecture & Interior Architecture

The School of Architecture at Auburn University, a comprehensive land-grant and research institution, seeks applicants for a full-time Visiting Assistant Professor with a dual appointment in the Architecture and Interior Architecture Programs, commencing August 2010. This is a two-year appointment with the possibility of renewal.

The School of Architecture at Auburn has a 100 year history of educating architects, interior architects, landscape architects and planners; and of contributing to the region and the profession through outreach, scholarship and creative work. The School has four allied degree programs: Bachelor of Architecture, Bachelor of Interior Architecture, Master of Landscape Architecture, and Master of Community Planning, and resides in the College of Architecture, Design, and Construction.

The Architecture Program serves over 375 students pursuing the first professional degree in architecture and strives to prepare these students to become outstanding professionals with leadership abilities who possess design and planning creativity, social responsibility, historical perspective, technical competence, and global environmental consciousness. The Bachelor of Interior Architecture degree is offered as an imbedded dual-degree with the Bachelor of Architecture degree.

Responsibilities of this position include teaching design studios in both architecture and interior architecture, along with lectures/seminars in sustainable design, history & theory of interiors, furniture design, interior materials and technologies, and/or graphic representation.

Minimum qualifications include a Master of Architecture, or a terminal degree in a related field. Desired qualifications include: teaching experience and/or professional experience in the field, evidence of research/creative scholarship or the ability to develop an active research/creative scholarly program, professional registration, and LEED accreditation.

Minorities and women are encouraged to apply.
