



## Assistant Professor of Architecture - Rural Studio Program

The School of Architecture at Auburn University in Auburn, Alabama, is accepting applications for a full time, tenure track position as an Assistant Professor in the School of Architecture. This position begins August 15, 2010. Salary will be competitive and commensurate with experience and qualifications.

This position is for instruction at the third year level of a professional Bachelor of Architecture degree program. Instruction is part of the Rural Studio, a design-build and outreach program within the degree program in the School of Architecture. Requirements for this position include: a master's degree in architecture or other terminal degree in a related field and evidence of outstanding design skills. Preferred qualifications include experience teaching in a degree program via a design-build teaching methodology.

Minorities and women are encouraged to apply.

This position includes teaching a design-build studio consisting of the design and construction of a wood framed structure, and courses in related subjects including construction technology, history, and contemporary issues related to housing and design theory. The studio will consist of a fall and spring semester of approximately fifteen students each. The successful candidate will work closely with the Directors and staff of the Rural Studio program. The location of instruction is Newbern, Alabama.
